Vernacular name: Inharezinho do Cerrado

2 km. N. of Xavantina.  
(52° 20' W - 14° 44' S.)

Shrub, 1 m tall, growing in cerrado.

The roots are used locally to produce a medicine used in the treatment of dermatitis. The vernac. name means little Inhazê of the cerrado (Inhazê = *Sorocea illicifolia*)
