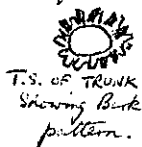
FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

No. R. 536

*Ourotea* aff. *spectabilis* (Mart.) Engl.

7 km. SW of Xavantina (52°20'W - 14°44'S).

Tree, 7.5 m tall. Bark silvery, fissured into a squarish pattern, longitudinally fluted where thicker.



Glaze: striking deep red wood, surrounded by pale coffee of the cut bark.

Very floriferous & visited by large numbers of bees. Petals golden-yellow.

Growing in Cerrado.
