Vernacular names: Fruta de Morcego, Mijo de
Guara.

1.5 km E of XAVANTINA (52° 20' W - 14° 44' S).

Small tree, 4 m tall. Growing in
rather dense cerrado.

The second vernacular name refers
to the rather nitrogenous smell of the
crushed tissues of some specimens (it means
maned-wolf's urine).
