**FLORA OF MATO GROSSO**

*Buchenavia tomentosa* Eichl.

7 km. SW of Xavantina (52°20'W - 14°44'S).

Tree, 8 m. tall. Trunk 12 cm. diameter at breast height. Bark silvery, longitudinally fissured. Blaze: wood pale green, inner bark yellow-brown, outer bark reddish brown.

Flower spikes yellow-green. Tree infested by ants.

Growing in cerrado on a rocky ridge crest.
