Erythroxylum suberosum Sr. Hil.

7 km. SW of XAVANTINA (52°20'W - 14°44'S).

Small tree, 4 m tall, branching almost from the base. Largest trunk 7 cm diameter at breast height. Blaze: wood almost white, surrounded by pale pink bark with a darker outer edge. Flowers cream.

Growing in cerrado formation.
