Tabebuia ochracea (Cham.) Standley
subsp. ochracea

7 km SW of XAVANTINA (52° 20' W - 14° 44' S).

Tree, 6.5 m tall. Trunk 13 cm diam. at breast height. Bark showing fire-charring at the base of the tree. Pith: wood yellowish cream; inner layer (very thin) of bark brown, outer broad layer of bark fawn. Flowers bright yellow.
