Qualea multiflora Mart.

Vernacular name: Pau Terra Lisa.

2 km. W. of XAVANTINA (52°20'W - 14°44'S).

Small tree, 4 m tall. Trunk 6.5 cm in diam. at breast height. Bark smooth, pinkish-brown, transverse striations encircling trunk.

Blaze: wood cream, surrounded by olive-brown bark. Petal white with yellow stripe in throat & dark red mottling at each side.

Date: 1.4.1968 Growing in dense cerrado. ALT: 500m
