Waltheria polyantha K. Sch.

Vernacular name: Malva.

Near the base camp of the Expedition, 12°54'S -
51°52'W (close to the XAVANTINA-SÃO FELIX road,
ca. 275 km. N. of Xavantina).

Shrub, 1.2 m tall. Arching branches with
distichous leaves. Bright yellow petals.
Growing in rather open grassy cerrado.
