8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.  
(Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W).

Shrub, 2 m tall. More or less unbranched  
with arching shoots from the base and  
distichous leaf arrangement. Flowers  
bright yellow.

Growing in grassy cerrado, with  
scattered trees to 6 m tall, on very sandy  
soil. ✓
