Copaifera Martii Hayne.

8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp at 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road.)

Vernacular name : Pau d'oi.

Subshrub to 65 cm tall. Sepals white,
petals 0. The 'oi' of the vernacular name
is a contraction of olho = eye.

Growing in cerrado on very sandy soil.
