Saccellium brasiliense l.M. Johnston

Corumbá, MS, 19°01'S 53°39'W, at the entrance of the new cemetery close to the airport, alt. 100 m.

Remains of deciduous forest on calcareous soils.

Tree, 8 m tall, 25 cm dbh. Pale fawn bark with vertical fissures (rather like Tabebuia). Fruiting calyces pale green. Ground below tree covered in dried-up fallen flowers (see capsule).
