Saccellium brasiliense I. M. Johnston

Corumbá, MS, 19°01'S 57°39'W, close to the limestone workings of the Pedreira de Xavier.

In remains of deciduous forest on calcareous rocks.

Tree, 14 m tall, 60 cm dbh with fawn, deeply longitudinally fissured bark. Fruiting calyx pale green, small corolla withered (many fallen corollas collected from the ground).
