Blade of frond 1m long x 1.6m broad, divided to near base into c. 70 divisions; stipe c. 80cm. Inflorescences to 80cm long with c. 15 floriferous bracts on each side of axis; ascending when with few fruits, pendent with many. Flowers yellow-green.

Small, young leaves selected for herbarium

specimens.
