In pasture on an area previously occupied
by deciduous forest on mesotrophic soil.

Tree, 10m tall, dividing into 6 ascending
trunks at 1m above ground level. Trunk
70cm dbh at point of division; thickest
ascending sub-trunk 25cm dbh.
