Conocarpus erectus L.

Vernacular name: Buttonwood

Belize District. Gale's Point (sea to Bar River), just south of Bar River mouth, Transect 1, c. 17°14'N 88°18'W

On the edge of the sandy beach at the mouth of the river.

Shrub, 3.5 m tall. Bark pale grey with rather warty lenticels. Flower heads yellow-green. Ripe fruits dark straw-brown.
