No. R. 6769 Duguetia mararawiana Mart. Vernacular name: Meijoí det Pung Hen Maas 1996 Carolina, close to the Rio Lajes, 7°21'S 47°26'W. In mesotrophic facies cerradão on the top of a river bank. Tree, 10m tall, 28cm dbh. Sepals greenish cream with a touch of gold. Petals creamy yellow at the tips, rose below. R 6768 is a nearby fruiting specimen of the same species. The vernacular name is interesting: meijo (Tupi-Guarani definitely not mijo!) seems to refer to some attribute of the Annonaceae Ephederanthus parviflorus is the 'Meijo de porco' in N Mato Grosso and 'Meijoí' is a diminutive.
