## Ruellia (Eurychanes) verbasciforms Wees

c. 14km from Alto Paraíso de Goiás (14°07'S 47°31'W) on the road to the Chapada dos Veadeiros National Park.

In cerrado vegetation on a flattish rocky area at the base of an escarpment.

Erect herb with unbranched shoots to 3m tall. Leaves in whorls of 3. Flowers with strong scent characteristic of bat-pollinated flowers (exactly like Cobaea scandens). Corollas pale lemon. A greasy/waxy, pleasantly scented deposit is left on hands after touching the plant, after a time this produces a strong burning sensation - everybody who handled the plant noticed this. There is a huge population here but I have never seen this conspicuous species elsewhere.
