Cavanillesia arborea K. Schum.

Vernacular name: Barriguda

Município de Manga.

Between Caninanha and Manga, approx. 14°20'S
43°55'W.

In remains of deciduous forest in which the large
'barrigudas' have been left standing.

Large tree, completely leafless at this time of
year, 20m tall, 2m dbh but swelling above –
maximum diameter at 3m above ground level.
Corky bark with characteristic knobby surface
(see separate specimen). Dry leaves, flowers
and fairly ripe fruits collected from ground.
Flowers orange-scarlet. Fruits dark rose colour.
