*Lueheopsis rosea* (Ducke) Burret

Vernacular name: Jangada

Matinha, c. 70km S of Riberão Cascalheira on the road to Nova Xavantina (BR158), 13°31'S 51°54'W.

In a boggy streamside with sparse gallery forest.

Small tree, 6m tall, 13cm dbh. Bark grey with pale horizontally elongated lenticels, slightly cracked and fissured. Epicalyx cinnamon brown; calyx waxy pink, darker within; corolla rose-pink to lilac; androecium bright yellow. Visited by small bees (e.g. *Trigona* sp. 'jataí') and wasps. Older trees have bark cracking in vertical fissures.
