Qualea parviflora Mart.

8 km NE of the Base Camp of the Expedition.
(Base Camp at 12° 54' S - 51° 52' W close to the
Xavantina-São Felix road.)

Vernacular name: Pau Terra Roxa.

Tree, 2 m tall. Bark grey, rugose. Blaze:
Wood yellow-white, surrounded by brown
cortex.

Growing at the junction of cerrado
and grassy campo.
