

## FLORA OF MATO GROSSO

No. R.1101

*Pseudobombax tomentosum* (Mart. & Zucc.) A. Rebyrs.

Vernacular name: Mamourana.

9 km E. of the Base Camp of the Expedition.  
 (Base Camp 12°54'S - 51°52'W, c. 270 km N.  
 of Xavantina).

Wide crowned tree, 9 m tall. Trunk 60 cm diameter  
 at breast height. Bark deeply fissured with  
 chlorophyllous tissue at the base of the furrows.

Growing in the transition region between  
 valley forest on rich soil and cerrado.

Date: 19.4.1968 This is a vegetative collection to  
 show leaves. R1856 is a flowering  
 collection from the same tree.
