Sclerobium aweum (Tw.) Benth

Vernacular name: Tingui Bata

Approx. 10 km S of Xavantina ( $14^{\circ}44'S$ ,  
 $52^{\circ}20'W$ ).

Tree, 7m tall, 13 cm in diam. at  
breast height.

Flowers golden yellow, strongly scented  
and very attractive to bees and wasps.

Vernacular name refers to the resemblance  
of the bark to 'Tingui' (Magonia pubescens) & to  
the cling-like smell of the wood when burned.
