Laryocarpus brasiliense Camb. ssp. *brasiliense*

Ilha do Bananal, Parque Nacional do Araguaia (IBDF),
nr HQ (c. 2 km from Macaúba, approx.

10°30'S 50°30' W). Vernacular name: Piquê

Wide-crowned tree, 8 m tall; trunk 60 cm d. b. h.

with bark flaking in an irregular pattern &
showing no charring; crown 15 m across with some
of the outermost branches practically touching the ground
— like a park beech.

Fruits edible. Flowers cream — collected from
the ground below another tree of the same sp.

In campo cerrado in a damp place on the
Date. 10.9.1980 edge of an area of campo with
mucundums.
