Bauhinia rufa (Bong.) Steud.

Brasília, Peninsula Norte QLI, on the slope overlooking the NE arm of Lago do Paranoá.

Low campo sujo with a considerable amount of bare ground between plants.

Renewable shrub/perennial herb producing a clump of unbranched shoots to 80 cm tall from an underground organ.

Petals white. Sepals yellow-green. Filaments white, turning pink on aging.
