Butea paraguayensis (B. Rodr.) L.H. Bailey  
Floresta de Angatuba (23°27'S 48°25'W),  
Instituto Florestal de SP.

In cerrado.

Small palm, 1.9 m tall to the tips of  
unfolding fronds. Stem  $\pm$  1 m tall,  
covered in persistent dead frond-bases  
(the lower of which have lost their  
blades; the upper still have the dead  
blades attached), amongst which is  
growing an epiphytic Elaphoglossum.

Fronds to 1.5 m, arching.
