In a 'paratudal', ie an open woodland
composed entirely of Tabebuia caraiba
(the 'paratudo').

Climbing to 4 m on a tree of T. caraiba.
Flowers pale yellow-green; petals with
brown bases; androecial horns white;
visited by ants. Copious white latex.
