*Schinopsis brasiliensis* Engl.

Vernacular name: Braúna

nr. Rio Parida (14°07'S 47°13'W), 31.5km from Alto Paraíso de Goiás on the road to Nova Roma.

In a patch of mesophytic forest, associated with *Anadenanthera colubrina*, *Astronium urundeuva*, *Machaerium angustifolium*, etc.

Tree, 13m tall, 35cm dbh. Bark grey, scaling in a pattern rather like Aroeira (*A. urundeuva*). Flowers yellow-green. Crushed leaves have smell of mango and the whole tree is emanating this odour.
