Roadside vegetation in a cultivated area previously occupied by mesophilous forest.

Spindly, straggling shrub, 1.8m tall, arching under its own weight. The long thick roots are pulled up and beaten in water to give a beer-flavoured drink -- hence the vernacular name, meaning poor man's beer. One of our party had often drunk it in his youth and said that it was very refreshing after working in the hot sun.
